Race 1 - 01:35 PM **FATEES AL HAJERI CUP**

AL KRUSH 1854 hung badly right-handed in the home straight.

Race 2 - 02:00 PM **(IMPORTED)**

Permission was given to FIFTH FLEET (IRE) to wear a hood in the parade ring. Permission was given to SAFRA (USA) to be mounted from the pre parade ring. The Stewards noted that around the 1000 metre mark JAMAIS ASSEZ (USA) unplaced hung right causing IBN ARABI (IRE) unplaced to shift onto MODMIN (IRE) placed second which in turn caused NEPTUNIAN (IRE) unplaced to shift right, which then caused NAYSLAYER (IRE) unplaced to be short of room. They were satisfied that no riding offenses had been committed and so took no further action.

Stephane Ladjadj the rider of NOTIONS (IRE) unplaced reported that having been allowed to run up with the pace the gelding weakened quickly in the home straight and might be better suited by being ridden with more restraint in the future.



Race 3 - 02:25 PM
(LOCAL BRED)

Permission was given to MURJANI to go to the start early.

Race 4 - 02:50 PM
(LOCAL BRED)

The starter reported that SAKHR trained by Haider Ebrahim had refused to enter the starting stalls and was withdrawn. The trainer was informed that SAKHR could not be entered for a race until having passed a stalls test. The trainer was further informed that if SAKHR were to be reported by the starter for a third consecutive time the colt may be suspended from racing for a period of time.

Race 5 - 03:15 PM
PORSCHE CUP

Stewards noted that the winner DEVASTE (GB) ridden by Neil Callan, hung badly left handed in the closing stages despite the rider best efforts, causing interference to ROSA MYSTICA (IRE) unplaced ridden by Hussain Maki. TOULOUSE LE PLOT reared high when the stalls opened.

Race 6 - 03:40 PM
PORSCHE CUP

A.Jaleel Al Mallah the trainer of ROOSEVELET'S GRIT (GB) requested to run the gelding to run in a visor in place of the blinkers which had been declared. The stewards interviewed the trainer who stated that he had declared blinkers in error and contacted the Stewards on declaration day as soon he realized his mistake. Permission was given for ROOSEVELT'S GRIT (GB) to run in a visor. They imposed a fine of BD 10 on the trainer.

Race 7 - 04:05 PM
BAHRAIN JEWELLERY CENTER CUP

RAMANI trained by Mohamed Hasan went to post wearing a hood to be removed at the start without having requested permission. The stewards drew the trainer attention to his responsibilities to ensure that any request of this nature is logged on the system when declaring.
