Race 1 - 05:30 pm

SAFRA CUP

KRUSHAN 1954, trained by Jaffar Marzooq, was withdrawn by the Stewards at 13:12 as there was no suitable Jockey available to ride.

The Regulatory Veterinary Officer reported that MLOLSHAN 1865, trained by Yousif Taher, had bled from the nose.

The Stewards enquired into whether Ali Isa, the rider of the winner KUHEILAN AAFAS 1952, had used his whip in this Hands and Heels race. Having reviewed the recordings and interviewed the rider, they found him in breach of the race conditions for using his whip down the shoulder inside the final 400m. The Stewards ordered that any points earned by Ali Isa in this race be forfeited and suspended him from riding in the next race in the Hands and Heels Apprentice Race Series.

Race 2 - 06:00 pm

CROWN INDUSTRIES B.S.C (C) CUP

KHAWAFY, MIND YOUR MANNERS, AL QAMAIRAH and AUTHORITY were given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring. SAKHR, BUDVA and AUTHORITY were given permission to wear hoods to the start. TOPAZ was given permission to go to the start early.

WARDA, ridden by Rosie Jessop, and NAAHY, ridden by Mohammed Jamil, both unplaced, were slowly away from the stalls.

FAWAAZ, placed 4th, ridden by Hussain Asghar, and BUDVA, unplaced, ridden by Stephane Ladjadj, both hung right-handed in the home straight.

The Stewards enquired into two possible incidents of interference inside the final 400m. In the first incident, approaching the 400m, they found that SAKHR, unplaced, ridden by Abdulla Faisal, had interfered with KHAWAFY, unplaced, ridden by Adnan Jaffar. Having reviewed the recordings and interviewed the riders, the Stewards cautioned Abdulla Faisal for careless riding for allowing SAKHR to shift left-handed when not sufficiently clear, causing KHAWAFY to be eased. In the second incident, around the 200m marker, they cautioned Lee Newman for careless riding for allowing MIND YOUR MANNERS to shift left-handed when not sufficiently clear, taking SAKHR off his intended line and causing interference to TOPAZ, unplaced, ridden by Ahmed Maki.



The Stewards noted that approaching the 200m MEAAD, placed 3rd, ridden by Ray Dawson, hung badly right-handed despite the rider's best efforts, causing interference to AUTHORITY, unplaced, ridden by Ebrahim Nader, which in turn caused interference to TAUFAN, unplaced, ridden by Hussain Maki, who had to be eased. Having reviewed the recordings, the Stewards were satisfied that no riding offence had been committed and took no further action.

The Regulatory Veterinary Officer reported that MEAAD lost his off-fore shoe during the race.

Race 3 - 06:30 pm

CROWN INDUSTRIES B.S.C (C) MILE CUP

RAWALPINDI EXPRESS (IRE), SHIPMASTER (GB), STELLAR ARROW (GB) and SUPERIOR (IRE) were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

Mohamed Hasan, trainer of STELLAR ARROW (GB), was cautioned for failing to request permission for a hood to be worn to the start.

SUPERIOR (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Ebrahim Nader, reared as the stalls opened and was slowly away.

SINJ (GB), placed 4th, ridden by Rosie Jessop, and RAWALPINDI EXPRESS (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Adnan Jaffar, both ran too free in the early stages of the race.

The Regulatory Veterinary Officer reported that SINJ (GB), trained by A. Jaleel Al Mallah, had bled from the nose.

Race 4 - 07:00 pm

AL SHARIF GROUP SPRINT CUP

BAATHER (IRE) were given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring. WOJTEK (IRE), MAYSTAR (IRE), VLAD (GB), JA'MARR (GB) and BROOKLYN NINE NINE (IRE) were given permission to wear hoods to the start. A staff member was given permission to assist with loading IBN ARABI (IRE) into the stalls.

The Stewards fined Jaber Ramadhan, the trainer of JA'MARR (GB), BD 30/- for failing to declare a rider by the close of declarations. Permission was given for Stephane Ladjadj to ride JA'MARR (GB).

A. Rahim Jasim, the rider of NEPTUNIAN (IRE), was cautioned for using the whip with excessive frequency inside the final 400m.



Qasim Jameel, the rider of CHIMGAN (IRE), unplaced, was fined BD 50/- for using the whip with excessive frequency inside the final 400m.

Race 5 - 07:30 pm

AL SHARIF GROUP BAHRAIN BRED CUP

SHGARDI and WAQIAAH were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

Race 6 - 08:00 pm

Race 6

MUSTABSHER was given permission to wear a hood to the start. THE LAST CALL was given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring.

Lee Newman, the rider of CARMELEON, unplaced, reported that the gelding ran flat. The Veterinary Officer reported no abnormalities with the horse during routine sampling.

The Stewards enquired into possible interference approaching the 400m between MANSOOB, unplaced, ridden by Mark Lawson, and BAIRAQ, placed 2nd, ridden by Aidan Keeley. Having reviewed the recordings and interviewed the riders, the Stewards cautioned Mark Lawson for careless riding for allowing MANSOOB to shift left-handed away from the whip, making contact with BAIRAQ, who was taken off his intended line.

Race 7 - 08:30 pm

LASER GUIDED (IRE), JARHAM (GB), WHATHAPPENSINVEGAS (IRE), LADY LYNX (IRE), MAHROUSA (GB) and CRYPTO PRINCESS (IRE) were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

WHATHAPPENSINVEGAS (IRE), ridden by Ebrahim Nader, and LASER GUIDED (IRE), ridden by A. Rahim Jasim, both unplaced, ran too free in the early stages of the race.

The Stewards noted that inside the final 200m, KING OF THE THRONE (USA), unplaced, ridden by Mirko Sanna, shifted left-handed, making slight contact with LASER GUIDED (IRE), unplaced, ridden by A. Rahim Jasim. Having reviewed the recordings, the Stewards were satisfied that no riding offence had been committed and took no further action.



Anas Al Siyabi, the rider of LADY LYNX (IRE), unplaced, reported that the mare hung left-handed in the home straight.

Race 8 - 09:00 pm
AL SHARIF GROUP CUP

GIMME SHELTER (USA) was given permission to wear a hood to the start. TARTAN CHIEF (GB), trained by Ali Abdulmajeed, was withdrawn by the Regulatory Veterinary Officer at 20:22.

The Stewards fined Jaber Ramadhan, the trainer of BURGLAR (GB), BD 50/- for failing to produce the correct colours. Permission was given for BURGLAR (GB) to run in all black colours.

BURGLAR (GB), unplaced, ridden by Ahmed Maki, ran too free in the early stages of the race.

A. Rahim Jasim, the rider of BATTYEFORD BOY (IRE), placed 2nd, was cautioned for using the whip with excessive frequency inside the final 400m.
