## **Race 1 - 04:00 pm HM THE KING'S CUP**

OBEYAN 1893 was given permission to wear a hood to the start.

KRUSHAN M1080, ridden by Hasan Al Saffar and trained by Reyadh Ahmed, was unruly in the stalls and withdrawn by the Starter at 4:00 pm. The trainer was informed that KRUSHAN M1080 could not be entered for a race until the horse had passed a stalls test.

KRUSHAN M1173, unplaced, ridden by Qasim Jameel, hung left-handed in the home straight, and the rider dropped their whip inside the final 100m.

A.Rahim Jasim, the rider of the winner, KUHEILAN AL ADIYAT 1894, was cautioned for using the whip with excessive frequency in the home straight.

Ali Isa, the rider of MUSANNAN 1927, unplaced, was fined BD 75/- for using the whip with excessive frequency and without allowing the horse sufficient time to respond in the back straight.

## **Race 2 - 04:30 pm GFH CUP**

SOCIAL DISTANCING was given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring and to have a staff member assist with loading at the stalls. CALIFORNIA was given permission to go to the start early and to wear a hood to the start.

Stephane Ladjadj, the rider of CALIFORNIA, unplaced, reported that the gelding changed his leads around the bend and shifted sharply left-handed. He added that, being concerned something was amiss, he eased CALIFORNIA in the straight. The Stewards ordered the gelding to be routinely tested. The Regulatory Veterinary Officer reported no abnormalities.



**Race 3 - 05:00 pm**  
**BAPCO ENERGIES CUP**

GORDON GREY (IRE), THE PARENT (GB), ANTELOPE (GB) and PHOENIX PASSION (IRE) were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

The Stewards held an enquiry into possible interference inside the final 100m between the winner, PHOENIX PASSION (IRE), ridden by Neil Callan, and GORDON GREY (IRE), placed 3rd, ridden by Lee Newman. Having viewed the recordings and interviewed the riders, the Stewards cautioned Neil Callan for careless riding for allowing PHOENIX PASSION (IRE) to drift right-handed, away from the whip, when not sufficiently clear, causing GORDON GREY (IRE) to have to be eased for a stride.

**Race 4 - 05:30 pm**  
**THE CHAIRMAN'S CUP BY BINAA**

AVA GO JOE (IRE), DREAM OUT LOUD (IRE) and GRAND GREY (IRE) were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

Lee Newman, the rider of DESERT COP (GB), unplaced, reported that the gelding missed the break.

Szczepan Mazur, the rider of CHANDIGAH (IRE), placed 4th, was cautioned for using the whip with excessive frequency from 400m out.

**Race 5 - 06:00 pm**  
**HM THE KING'S CUP**

TAARIS was given permission to go to the start early. MANIKAN was given permission to be mounted in the pre-parade ring. MIDHAAL, TAARIS, MAJARAH and MANIKAN were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

HATTAAB, unplaced, ridden by Abdulla Faisal, stumbled on leaving the stalls.

BARAAK, placed 2nd, ridden by Neil Callan, and MEDITERRANEAN MOON, placed 4th, ridden by Lee Newman, both ran too free during the early stages of the race.

Ebrahim Nader, the rider of the winner, REALM, was fined BD 100/- for using the whip with excessive frequency in the home straight.



A.Rahim Jasim, the rider of the MIDHAAL, placed 3rd, was fined BD 150/- for using the whip with excessive frequency and without allowing the gelding sufficient time to respond in the home straight.

**Race 6 - 06:30 pm**  
**HM THE KING'S CUP**

CALIF (GER) was given permission to go to the start early. REFRESHMENT (IRE), PANNING FOR GOLD (IRE), PHANTOM FLIGHT (GB), CRACKSKING (GB), CALIF (GER), WESTRIDGE (FR) and SOVEREIGN SPIRIT (GB) were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

Stephane Ladjadj, the rider of CALIF (GER), placed 4th, was cautioned for using the whip with excessive frequency in the home straight.

Benoit De La Sayette, the rider of the winner, PHANTOM FLIGHT (GB), was cautioned for celebrating before the winning line.

**Race 7 - 07:00 pm**  
**AL METHAQ MILE**

BYLINE (GB), PIZ NAIR (IRE) and HI ROYAL (IRE) were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

**Race 8 - 07:30 pm**  
**THE AVENUES-BAHRAIN CUP**

PISCES was given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring. MIJWAAD, SAN DIEGO, and PISCES were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

SAN DIEGO, unplaced, ridden by Hussain Makki, ran too free during the early stages of the race.
