Race 1 - 17:00

AL WASMIYA CUP

MUSANNAN M1155 was given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring.

The Stewards enquired into why Yousif Taher's runners, AL SAQLAWY 1934 and OBEYAN 1958, were late arriving to the pre-parade ring. The Stewards accepted the trainer's explanation that he was unavoidably delayed by a road closure and took no further action.

AL SAQLAWY M1125, unplaced, ridden by Hussain Asghar, reared as the stalls opened and was slowly away.

AL HAMDANY 1965, unplaced, ridden by Qasim Jameel, ran too free in the early stages of the race.

KRUSHAN M1173, ridden by Husain Makki, placed 3rd, hung left-handed in the home straight.

Race 2 - 17:25

RACE 2

MISS HATHAWAY (GB), GHAALEB (NZ), KOULIKORO (IRE) and BAATHER (IRE) were given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring. KOULIKORO (IRE), BAMBALAM (FR), MISS HATHAWAY (GB), CASSANDER and SUPERIOR (IRE) were given permission to wear hoods to the start. MISS HATHAWAY (GB) and GHAALEB (NZ) were given permission to go to the start early.

GHAALEB (NZ), ridden by Ahmed Maki, and SALVUCCIO (GB), ridden by Qasim Jameel, both unplaced, were slowly away from the stalls.

Husain Makki, the rider of GARSMAN (IRE), placed 3rd, was cautioned for using the whip with excessive frequency in the home straight.

MUJTAHID, ridden by Rosie Jessop, lost his left hind shoe during the race.

Race 3 - 17:50

FUTURE STARS SPRINT LEG 2

SONIC BOOM, QUEENS COUNSEL, MIND POWER, CORNER POCKET and SHAREEFA were given permission to wear hoods to the start. SHAREEFA was given permission to go to the start early.



Race 4 - 18:15

FUTURE STARS CHAMPIONS LEG 2

CASHEL, MAYMON, BALBOA, HUNTERS CALL and ALGHARBI were given permission to wear hoods to the start. BALBOA was given permission to go to the start early.

This race was late off due to a slow load.

MAYMON, unplaced, ridden by Husain Makki, and HUNTERS CALL, placed 3rd, ridden by Ebrahim Nader, both ran too free in the early stages of the race.

CAPTAIN NEMO, unplaced, ridden by Lee Newman, was unruly in the parade ring and at the start, rearing and unseating his rider when being loaded into the stalls.

Hasan Al Saffar, the rider of DIYAR, unplaced, was fined BD 25/- for using the whip in the forehead position down the horse's shoulder in the home straight.

YASALAM, placed 4th, ridden by A.Rahim Jasim, hung left-handed in the home straight.

The Regulatory Veterinary Officer reported that MIYBAAHY, unplaced, ridden by Abdulla Faisal, had been struck into from behind during the race.

Race 5 - 18:40

REHC CUP

SOCIAL DISTANCING was given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring and to have a member of staff assist with loading. WANISA and CALIFORNIA were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

WANISA, unplaced, ridden by Benoit De La Sayette, ran too free in the early stages of the race.



Race 6 - 19:05

APPLIED SCIENCE UNIVERSITY CUP

WHATHAPPENSINVEGAS (IRE) was given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring. AL SHABABI and CHANNAGIDE were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

The Stewards, acting on a report from the Regulatory Veterinary Officer, noted that CHANNAGIDE (USA), trained by Jaber Ramadhan, had not received a booster vaccination as required under Annexe 9 - Vaccination Protocols. The Trainer was found in breach of Article 21.6 and fined BD 200/-. He was informed that CHANNAGIDE (USA) cannot run again until the horse has completed a new primary vaccination course.

AL SHABABI (GB), unplaced, ridden by Ebrahim Nader, ran too free in the early stages of the race.

MOSSAAFER (IRE), placed 4th, ridden by A.Rahim Jasim, was denied a clear run inside the final 400m.

Race 7 - 19:30

LATE MR. ABDULLA AHMED NASS CUP

MAXIMUM IMPACT (GB), CRACKING GOLD (GB), COMPETIZIONE (FR), BUSSENTO (GB), COVER POINT (GB) and PIZ NAIR (IRE) were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

CRACKING GOLD (GB), place 2nd, ridden by Ebrahim Nader, ran too free in the early stages of the race.

Abdulla Faisal, the rider of the winner, PIZ NAIR (IRE), dropped his left rein on the run to the line.



Race 8 - 19:55

RACE 8

NAWADI, ESRAR and MUNAWARA were given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring. NAWADI, MUNAWARA, DARISS and EL BASMA were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

The Stewards held an enquiry into two incidents of possible interference.

The first incident, approaching the 200m, involved PRINCESS OF MONACO, ridden by Lee Newman, NAWADI, ridden by Husain Makki, and MUNAWARA, ridden by Ebrahim Nader, all unplaced. Having viewed the recordings and interviewed the riders, the Stewards found Lee Newman guilty of careless riding and fined him BD 100/- for allowing PRINCESS OF MONACO to shift sharply right-handed into an insufficient gap without correction, causing NAWADI and MUNAWARA to become unbalanced and be eased off heels.

The second incident, inside the 200m, involved FAWAAZ, unplaced, ridden by Hussain Asghar, who shifted right-handed, despite his rider's best efforts, moving MUNAWARA off her intended line. The Stewards found this interference to be accidental and took no further action.

Hasan Al Saffar, the rider of MEAAD, placed 2nd, was cautioned for using the whip with excessive frequency in the home straight.

Race 9 - 20:20

RACE 9

CAPRICORNUS was given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring, to go to the start early, and to have a member of staff assist with loading. MIND YOUR MANNERS was given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring. Ali Isa, the rider of the winner, AL NAYELAH, was fined BD 100/- for using the whip with excessive frequency in the home straight and BD 25/- for celebrating before the winning line, this being his second offence of this nature this season. The Stewards held an enquiry into two possible incidents of interference.

The first incident, approaching the 1000m marker, involved DALAYIL, unplaced, ridden by Abdulla Faisal, BUDGET, placed 3rd, ridden by Hussain Asghar, CAMPOLINA, unplaced, ridden by Edinson Rodriguez and MIND YOUR MANNERS, unplaced, ridden by Lee Newman. Having viewed the recordings and interviewed the riders, the Stewards found Abdulla Faisal guilty of careless riding and fined him BD 50/- for allowing DALAYIL to shift left-handed when not



sufficiently clear, shifting BUDGET off his intended line, which in turn caused CAMPOLINA to be snatched up.

The second incident, inside the final 400m, involved TAUFAN, unplaced, ridden by Husain Makki, the winner, MIND YOUR MANNERS, and BUDGET. The Stewards found Husain Makki guilty of careless riding and fined him BD 50/- for allowing TAUFAN to shift left-handed, causing interference to MIND YOUR MANNERS, who in turn interfered with BUDGET.

Race 10 - 20:45

RACE 10

BEATRICE SHILLING (GB), ANGELO PIO (IRE), GLORIOUSLY SASSY (GB) and THE PARENT (GB) were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

The Regulatory Veterinary Officer reported that BEATRICE SHILLING (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Husain Makki, had bitten her tongue.
