## **Race 1 - 04:00 pm**

### **RACE 1**

MUSANNAN M1155 was given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring. MUSANNAN M1155 and AL SAQLAWIEH M1070 were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

Yousif Taher, the trainer of AL MA'ANAGY 1971, requested permission for the colt to wear cheekpieces which had not been declared at the declaration stage. The Stewards granted permission for AL MA'ANAGY 1971 to wear cheekpieces and cautioned the trainer for failing to declare them.

Ali Isa, the rider of KUHEILAN AAFAS 1952, placed 3rd, dropped his whip inside the final 400m.

The Stewards noted interference on leaving the stalls when AL SHAWAF 1921, unplaced, ridden by Husain Makki, jumped sharply left-handed, taking the winner, AL MA'ANAGY 1971, ridden by Mohammed Jamil and AL SUWAIIEH 1953, unplaced, ridden by Qasim Jameel, off their intended lines. Having reviewed the recordings, the Stewards were satisfied that no riding offence had been committed and took no further action.

## **Race 2 - 04:30 pm**

### **RACE 2**

NAWADI was given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring. MIBLISH was given permission to go to the start early. NAWADI, EL BASMA and RETAJ were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

The Stewards, acting on a report from the Regulatory Veterinary Officer, noted that MAGSOODA, trained by Yousif Alboainain, had not received a booster vaccination as required under Annexe 9 – Vaccination Protocols. The Trainer was found in breach of Article 21.6 and fined BD 100/-. He was informed that MAGSOODA cannot run again until the horse has completed a new primary vaccination course.

BATMOBILE, unplaced, ridden by Tharb Al Timyat, was resaddled at the start.

WARDA, unplaced, ridden by Adnan Jaffar, reared as the stalls opened and was slowly away.

The Regulatory Veterinary Officer reported that NAWADI, unplaced, ridden by Mohammed Jamil, lost his left front shoe during the race.



The Stewards held an enquiry into whether Zuhair Majeed, the rider of NAAHY, unplaced, had used his whip before leaving the stalls. Having interviewed the rider, the Stewards noted his explanation that he had been waving the whip at the gelding before the stalls opened and had not made contact.

**Race 3 - 05:00 pm**  
**PALACE ENTERPRISES CUP**

SAN DIEGO was given permission to go to the start early. QUEENS COUNSEL, MIND POWER, SAN DIEGO and ROTTERDAM were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

**Race 4 - 05:30 pm**  
**REHC SPRINT CUP**

BURDETT (IRE) was given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring. GWEN JOHN (IRE), RAMAZAN (IRE), BURDETT (IRE) and MAXIMUM IMPACT (GB) were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

The Stewards enquired into why Stephane Ladjadj, the rider of NATIONWIDE (IRE), unplaced, stopped riding approaching the 100m marker when in second place and finished 5th, beaten 8 and  $\frac{1}{4}$  lengths. They interviewed the rider and reviewed the race recordings. The rider stated that NATIONWIDE (IRE) changed leads approaching the 100-metre marker, and he thought he might have gone wrong. The Regulatory Veterinary Officer reported that he had examined the gelding twice during routine testing and found no abnormalities. The Stewards fined Stephane Ladjadj BD 400/- for failing to ride his horse out to achieve the best possible placing.

**Race 5 - 06:00 pm**  
**SGB FUTURE STARS SPRINT CUP**

FURY and CORNER POCKET were given permission to wear hoods to the start.



## **Race 6 - 06:30 pm**

### **FUTURE STARS CHAMPIONS CUP**

SHAREEFA was given permission to go to the start early. CHINESE WHISPER, HUNTERS CALL, CALL TO ARMS and THAHABIYA were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

The Stewards, acting on a report from the Regulatory Veterinary Officer, noted that ABABEEL and SARMADI, trained by Haider Ebrahim, had both not received their booster vaccinations as required under Annexe 9 – Vaccination Protocols. The Trainer was found in breach of Article 21.6 and fined BD 800/- (BD 400/- for each horse). He was informed that ABABEEL and SARMADI cannot run again until the horses have completed new primary vaccination courses.

THAHABIYA, unplaced, ridden by Mohammed Jamil, was slowly away from the stalls.

## **Race 7 - 07:00 pm**

### **RACE 7**

JEHANGEER (IRE), KOULIKORO (IRE) and ROSA MYSTICA (IRE) were given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring. JARHAM (GB) was given permission to wear a hood in the parade ring. ROSA MYSTICA (IRE) was given permission to have a member of staff assist with loading into the stalls. SUPERIOR (IRE), JEHANGEER (IRE), CATHERINE PARR (IRE), COMPETIZIONE (FR), BAMBALAM (FR), KOULIKORO (IRE) and COVER POINT (GB) were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

The Stewards, acting on a report from the Regulatory Veterinary Officer, noted that KOULIKORO (IRE), trained by Jaffar Radhi, had not received a booster vaccination as required under Annexe 9 – Vaccination Protocols. The Trainer was found in breach of Article 21.6 and fined BD 100/-. He was informed that KOULIKORO (IRE) cannot run again until the horse has completed a new primary vaccination course.

Jaffar Radhi, the trainer of ROSA MYSTICA (IRE), was cautioned by the Stewards for booking the rider Salem Alajmi without confirming his availability to ride. The Stewards gave permission for Rosie Jessop to ride ROSA MYSTICA (IRE).

RA'S AL HADD (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Tharb Al Timyat, was resaddled at the start.



Alberto Sanna, the rider of COVER POINT (GB), placed 2nd, was fined BD 100/- for using the whip with excessive frequency in the home straight.

### **Race 8 - 07:30 pm**

#### **REHC CUP**

SOLDIER'S EMPIRE (IRE) was given permission to go to the start early. AL SHABABI (GB), SOLDIER'S EMPIRE (IRE), MR IRRELEVANT (IRE) and THE PARENT (GB) were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

Stephane Ladjadj reported that SOLDIER'S EMPIRE (IRE), unplaced, ran free during the early stages of the race and had no more to give in the home straight.

### **Race 9 - 08:00 pm**

#### **RACE 9**

EVERGREEN was given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring. TOMAHAWK was given permission to go to the start early. TOMAHAWK, EVERGREEN, CALL ME MAYBE, COSMIC POWER and MAJARAH were given permission to wear hoods to the start.

Jaber Ramadhan, the trainer of CALL ME MAYBE, was fined BD 50/- for failing to produce the correct colours. Permission was given for CALL ME MAYBE to run in all black colours.

HATTAAB, unplaced, ridden by A.Rahim Jasim, reared as the stalls opened and was slowly away.

EPIC, unplaced, ridden by Ali Isa, was denied a clear run inside the final 400 metres.

Qasim Jameel, the rider of COSMIC POWER, placed 2nd, was fined BD 100/- for using the whip with excessive frequency in the home straight.

Ebrahim Nader, the rider of the winner, EVERGREEN, was fined BD 75/- for celebrating before the winning line; this being the third of this nature this season.
