Race 1 - 14/11/2025 03:50 pm GULF AIR CUP

KRUSHAN 1926 was given permission to go to the start early.
KRUSHAN M1092, unplaced, ridden by Hussain Asghar, reared as the stalls opened and was slowly away.
The Stewards enquired into possible interference approaching the 200m marker between MLOLSHAN 1912, placed 3rd, ridden by Ali Isa, and KRUSHAN M1092, unplaced, ridden by Hussain Asghar. Having reviewed the recordings and interviewed the riders, accompanied by the Jockey Coach, Colin Rayner, the Stewards fined Ali



Isa BD 50/- for careless riding for allowing MLOLSHAN 1912 to shift left-handed away from the whip without correction, taking KRUSHAN M1092 off his intended line.

Race 2 - 14/11/2025 04:20 pm
BROWN ADVISORY CUP

BUDVA, TOMAHAWK, and PISCES were given permission to wear hoods and have them removed at the stalls. PISCES was given permission to be mounted from the pre-parade ring.

The Stewards noted that BUDVA, unplaced, ridden by Husain Makki, drifted right-handed and lost his action inside the final 200m.

Marcialis Jaures, the rider of SINATRA, placed 3rd, was fined BD 50/- for using the whip with excessive frequency in the home straight.

Race 3 - 14/11/2025 04:50 pm
LEXUS CUP

LIVING ART and MIDHAAL were given permission to wear hoods and have them removed at the stalls. LIVING ART was given permission to go to the start early.

LIVING ART, unplaced, ridden by Alberto Sanna, was slowly away from the stalls.

RIDER ON THE STORM, placed 4th, ridden by Marcialis Jaures, ran too free during the early stages of the race.

Lee Newman, rider of MEDITERRANEAN MOON, placed 2nd, objected to the winner, MIDHAAL, ridden by Dylan Browne McMonagle, on the grounds that Mr McMonagle had steered MIDHAAL right-handed into his mount, causing interference on leaving the back straight. The Stewards held an enquiry and, having reviewed the recordings and interviewed the riders, they found that as MIDHAAL passed MEDITERRANEAN MOON, Mr Newman eased off the heels of MUDALLAL, which was unplaced and ridden by Soufiane Saadi, ahead of him at the time. They were satisfied that the interference was accidental and that MIDHAAL did not cause it. They therefore dismissed the objection and ordered the placings to remain unaltered.

Race 4 - 14/11/2025 05:20 pm
BAPCO ENERGIES CUP

TAWAAREQ (IRE), PANNING FOR GOLD (IRE), BLEAK (IRE), VESTIGIA, SIGNALMAN (IRE), and INTRICACY (GB) were given permission to wear hoods and have them removed at the stalls. TAWAAREQ (IRE), BLEAK (IRE), and SIGNALMAN (IRE) were given permission to go to the start early.

The Clerk of the Scales objected to Soufiane Saadi, the rider of ZAGATO, placed 3rd, trained by Fawzi Nass, for weighing in more than 0.5kg underweight at 61.2kg. Having interviewed the rider, trainer's representative, and Clerk of the Scales, the Stewards disqualified ZAGATO (GB) and revised the placings. ROLLAJAM (IRE) was placed 3rd, and SIGNALMAN (IRE) was placed 4th. Having examined the weight cloth, they were satisfied that the underweight was due to a piece of lead having fallen out of one of the pockets, which had broken. They took no further action.



Race 5 - 14/11/2025 05:50 pm
BEYON CUP

BURDETT (IRE), HAWAIIAN (GB), MEARALL (IRE), and INDISPENSABLE (GB) were given permission to wear hoods and have them removed at the stalls.

The Veterinary Officer reported that the winner, BURDETT (IRE), ridden by Ebrahim Nader, trained by Ali Jan bled from the nose.

Race 6 - 14/11/2025 06:20 pm
GRAND SEIKO - BAHRAIN JEWELLERY CENTRE CUP

LABALABA (FR), QASEEM (IRE), AVA GO JOE (IRE), and REDEMPTION TIME were given permission to wear hoods and have them removed at the stalls. LABALABA (FR) was given permission to go to the start early.

AVA GO JOE (IRE), placed 2nd, ridden by Ebrahim Nader, was resaddled at the start. REDEMPTION TIME (GB), unplaced, ridden by Mirko Sanna, was unsettled in the stalls and slowly away.

Race 7 - 14/11/2025 06:50 pm
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BOARD CUP

SALAMANCA LAD (IRE) was given permission to wear a hood and have it removed at the stalls.

Mirko Sanna, the rider of MEHMENTO (IRE), placed 4th, was cautioned for not giving his horse sufficient time to respond to his whip inside the final 200m.

Race 8 - 14/11/2025 07:40 pm
BAHRAIN INTERNATIONAL TROPHY

Pride of Arras (IRE), Lion's Pride (GB), Calif (GER), Persica (IRE), and Military Order (IRE) were given permission to wear hoods and have them removed at the stalls.

CALIF (GER), ridden by Alberto Sanna, and LION'S PRIDE (GB), ridden by Robert Havlin, were slowly away from the stalls.
